No Hidden Fees.

Tuition/Program Fees - include the arts and social science tuition charged by the host university for a normal course load. However, Asian universities charge extra tuition if students exceed a normal course load and/or charge a higher tuition for disciplines such as science, engineering and other specialty areas involving laboratory, studio, or field work. Since these extra tuition fees apply to very few students, and are not known until after registration, they are not included in the published program fee. They are billed separately after classes have been in session for several weeks and all enrollments are finalized. In these situations, students will receive an invoice from either The Education Abroad Network or the host institution.

Housing Cost Range - In some locations, participants will be able to select on or off-campus accommodation so we need to list a range of housing costs. Please consult our website and your TEAN Program Manager for specific details on each housing option and to learn more about many that are inclusive of items other programs exclude.

Meal Plans - the cost of meals is not included in the program fees listed above. In some locations on-campus students will be able to purchase an optional meal plan on arrival. Meal plan costs range from \$1,500 - \$3,000 depending on the number of meals provided and the location. Please consult your TEAN Program Manager for information on meal plan availability, costs, and locations where they are available.

*A partial meal plan is included for TEAN's Thailand programs, students will be given a monetary stipend which should cover two meals a day while class is in session, Monday-Friday.

Housing Deposits - All participants are required to pay a \$300 housing deposit in addition to the Program Fee. This fee is refundable at the conclusion of the program, less any damages, fines or outstanding debts. Most security deposits actually range in cost from \$700 to \$1,500 so we fund a large portion of this deposit as a courtesy. This ultimately means less funds you need to pay upfront and the convenience of dealing with a USA based organization for your refund.

*There is also an option for students studying at SMU to take three courses for a reduced tuition price of \$9,600. Choosing this option requires special approval from your home university to take only three courses.
