B. Course Objectives

After completing the course, students are expected

1. to build up fluency in using Chinese

5. to strengthen their awareness of intercultural issues

C. Course Description

This course

1. guides students through the basics of Chinese communication skills such as telephoning, employing Chinese in social situations, taking part in meetings, *etc.*
2. helps students improve fluency through interesting discussion activities, watching movies and TV series, singing Chinese songs, home-stay in Chinese families, meeting important business people at dinner table, cultural excursions, *etc.*
3. develops listening skills such as listening for information on the radio and TV.
4. Enhances reading proficiency.
